American Housing Foundation Teams Up With *Vitamin Relief USA*TM

Local Children to Receive Free Daily Vitamins at

*Fairway Village, Santa Maria Village, and Trestles of Austin Apartments
Through New Vitamin Distribution Program*

Austin, Texas--- To improve the quality of life of our children, American Housing Foundation brings to Austin *Vitamin Relief USA*TM, a national program that provides free daily multi-vitamins to children in need.

Parents and teachers of children already participating in *Vitamin Relief USA*TM have reported dramatic improvements in health, grades, school attendance, social behavior and self-esteem. Parents and teachers also reported marked improvements in energy levels, concentration, and a decrease in seasonal illnesses.

In this collaboration with AHF, *Vitamin Relief USA*TM will provide high-quality daily multi-vitamin/minerals for approximately 700 children each month. AHF will distribute the vitamins to

the parents of the participating children. The parents will also receive free educational materials on the correct use and benefits of vitamin supplementation for their children.

Vitamin Relief USA™ programs currently provide high quality, chewable multi vitamin/minerals to over 17,000 at-risk children a day, in 44 states in over 500 collaborative partner sites, including public schools. *Vitamin Relief USA™* is a tax-exempt, non-profit foundation committed to improving the health status of children and seniors through vitamin supplementation

Vitamin Relief USA™ is currently conducting a definitive double-blind study funded by the U.S. Congress. This study will measure improvements in academic performance and behavior in several thousand school children participating in the vitamin program.
